Please make sure all items are checked off before you send your recollection.

- Letter stating reason why the CPE Supervisor Final Evaluation(s) cannot be submitted
- Certificate of Completion for the unit must accompany the Written Recollection
- Explanatory letter from former CPE Supervisor(s) regarding missing evaluation
- List date(s) when the unit(s) were taken and successfully completed
- List where the unit(s) were taken and center's accreditation
- List the name(s) of the CPE supervisor(s)
- For each missing CPE Supervisor Final Evaluation, submit a full "Written Recollection" of candidate's experience and learning, which should include:

- information that would have been included in the CPE Supervisor Final Evaluation(s). Including learning goals development
- type of institution
- unit responsibilities
- interaction with staff, patients, and families
- relationship to CPE peers and supervisor
